You will need to bring with you:

- Black Pilot fineliner; red Pilot fineliner; Pritt glue; scissors; HB pencil; short & long ruler; eraser; coin (circular) stencil; 2 x A2 (635mm x 520mm) white cardboard; 2 x A4 pale pink cardboard; 5 x A4 blue cardboard; 2 x A4 sheets fine brown sandpaper.
- For the Modern Day Reading Cards, bring a set of six suitable pictures in duplicate. Examples of suitable topics are: modern technology (i.e. computers, fax, cell phone etc); endangered animals and space travel.
